This agreement (Agreement) is made between the Regents of the University of Colorado, a body corporate, acting on behalf of the University of Colorado Boulder, College of Engineering and Applied Science's *TeachEngineering Alliance* (hereinafter called "*TeachEngineering*") and \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter called "Contributor").

3. The term "Contribution" means all of Contributor's past and present contributions of curriculum, object code, source code, and documentation to *TeachEngineering*, however submitted to *TeachEngineering*, as described on Attachment A.
4. Contributor hereby grants to *TeachEngineering* a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide, no-charge, royalty-free license to Contributor's Contributions. Contributor agrees never to assert against *TeachEngineering* or its licensees or transferees any moral rights therein. Contributor understands that (i) this Agreement may be submitted by *TeachEngineering* to register a copyright in Contributor's Contribution, and (ii) *TeachEngineering* may exercise all rights as a copyright owner of Contributor's Contribution, including enforcement against infringers. *TeachEngineering* has no duty whatsoever to consult Contributor, obtain the consent of, pay or render an accounting to Contributor for any use or distribution of a Contribution or derivative work thereof.
5. Contributor hereby grants to *TeachEngineering* a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide, no-charge, royalty-free license under any patents owned or licensable by Contributor at any time without payment to third parties, to make, have made, use, sell, offer to sell, import and otherwise transfer Contributor's Contribution in whole or in part, alone or in combination with or included in any product, work or materials arising out of the *TeachEngineering* collection to which Contributor's Contribution was submitted, and to sublicense the foregoing rights to third parties through multiple tiers of sub-licensees or other licensing mechanisms at *TeachEngineering's* option.
6. Except as set forth above, Contributor retains solely the right, title and interest in and to Contributor's Contribution to use the Contribution for contributor's own and Contributor's organization's internal purposes. This license is limited to Contributor's Contributions only.
7. Contributor warrants that each of Contributor's Contributions to *TeachEngineering* is Contributor's original creation and does not violate any laws, breach any contracts, or violate the rights of any person or entity and is free of any liens or claims. Contributor warrants that Contributor has full power to make this Agreement. Contributor warrants that Contributor's Contribution submission(s) include complete details of any third-party license or other restriction (including, but not limited to,

related patents, trademarks, and license agreements) that are associated with any part of Contributor's Contributions. Contributor agrees to notify *TeachEngineering* of any facts or circumstances of which you become aware that would make Contributor's representations in this Agreement inaccurate in any respect.

8. Contributor warrants that Contributor is legally entitled to assign the rights described in paragraph 4 and paragraph 5. If Contributor's employer(s) have rights to intellectual property that Contributor creates, Contributor warrants that Contributor has received permission to make Contributor's Contributions on behalf of that employer.
9. Contributor agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless *TeachEngineering*, its officers, employees and agents from any damages, including any reasonable attorney's fees that arise from any breach of any warranty or relating to Contributor's Contributions.
10. *TeachEngineering* will make reasonable efforts to manage Contributor's Contributions in perpetuity, developing them as appropriate to make them available for non-commercial use. Although due care will be made to preserve the physical integrity of Contributor's Contributions, *TeachEngineering* shall incur no liability for the loss or damage to Contributor's Contributions.
11. This Agreement shall become effective when it is dated and signed by both parties.
